I am contacting you with a sponsorship opportunity for the Mokala Mountain Bike Classic, a major fund-raising event held each year in the Mokala National Park.

SANParks Honorary Rangers is the official and volunteer organisation of the South African National Parks. It is a registered Public Benefit and Non-profit organisation.

How can individuals get involved?

Any person over the age of 18 years, who is a permanent resident of South Africa, and is passionate about our national parks, can apply to become a member of the SANParks Honorary Rangers. Persons do not need conservation training to become a member.

We offer members of the public the opportunity to become involved in a wide variety of activities. The SANParks Honorary Rangers offer a selection of courses to our members to help them develop their skills.

Once an application has been approved, the applicant will be required to attend and successfully complete the SANParks Honorary Rangers membership course, which will inform them how we function and interact with the SANParks and the public. The new applicant also needs to attend the regional meetings in his/her area. Active participation in projects and activities will count in his/her favour when a final decision is made whether to appoint the applicant as a member. Applicant must get a total of 100 points in order to be appointed as a full member.

How can the Business Community Help?

We provide the business community the opportunity to partner with us to support conservation projects which have been identified by South African National Parks. Funds donated to the SANParks Honorary Rangers are used for conservation purpose for which they were donated. We use no public money to run our activities and money donated by the public for counter poaching or other projects identified, is used to fund the actual projects or counter poaching needs in our national parks.
